Nikki Porcher is a **U.S. Air Force veteran**, former **public school teacher**, and **founder** of award-winning nonprofit organization Buy From A Black Woman. She recently won the Democratic primary runoff for **Georgia Commissioner of Labor**, securing the Democratic nomination for the November 3, 2026 general election.

Her background is in building fair labor systems, expanding equitable opportunity, and strengthening local economies through data-driven policy.

As a small business advocate, **Nikki has supported over 700 business owners**, by providing funding, training, and certification pathways that help them grow and hire more employees.

Over the last decade, Nikki has:

- Helped business owners generate more than **\$6.12 million** in revenue.
- Built a community of **280,200 supporters** and allies.
- Secured **16 partnerships** with major organizations like PayPal, Goldman Sachs and H&M;

government agencies like the IRS and the FTC, and programs like the Biden Administration's White House Initiative on Advancing Educational Excellence, Equity, and Economic Opportunity for Black Americans.

- Won **11 awards**, including *Woman of the Year Government or Nonprofit*, *Achievement in Diversity & Inclusion*, and *Social Activist of the Year*.

Throughout her career, Nikki has taken has worked in service of others. She **served her country** for 8 years, stationed at *Robins Air Force Base* in Warner Robins, GA and deployed to Iraq and Afghanistan.

While working at Macon Habitat For Humanity, she **connected families to job opportunities**, housing, and resources. And as a public school teacher, she **created skill-building incubators** and mentored students while serving in the Dekalb County School District.

Nikki's work across service, education, and business has always centered on the principle that **when people have access to fair systems and real support, they thrive.**



Nikki is running for Georgia Labor Commissioner to **put people first**, by protecting workers and ensuring the Department of Labor works for every community across the state.
